Dear Colleagues,

I am writing to formally confirm NYU Tandon School of Engineering's policy to waive English language proficiency test requirements for applicants who have earned a degree from select Sino-foreign institutions in China where English is the sole language of instruction.

Effective immediately, applicants who have completed a bachelor's or master's degree from the following Sino-foreign institutions are eligible for an English language test waiver:

- 1. NYU Shanghai Shanghai East China Normal University & New York University (USA)
- 2. Xi'an Jiaotong-Liverpool University Suzhou Xi'an Jiaotong University & University of Liverpool (UK)
- 3. **Duke Kunshan University** Kunshan Wuhan University & Duke University (USA)
- 4. University of Nottingham Ningbo China Ningbo Zhejiang Wanli University & University of Nottingham (UK)
- 5. **The Chinese University of Hong Kong, Shenzhen** Shenzhen *Shenzhen University & CUHK (Hong Kong)*
- 6. **Wenzhou-Kean University** Wenzhou *Wenzhou University & Kean University (USA)*
- 7. **Hong Kong University of Science and Technology (Guangzhou)** Guangzhou *Guangzhou University & HKUST (Hong Kong)*
- 8. Beijing Normal University-Hong Kong Baptist University United International College (UIC) Guangdong
 Beijing Normal University & Hong Kong Baptist University (Hong Kong)

9. **Guangdong Technion–Israel Institute of Technology** – Guangdong *Shantou University & Technion–Israel Institute of Technology (Israel)*

Applicants from these institutions will not be required to submit TOEFL, IELTS, or equivalent English proficiency scores, provided the degree was completed fully in English. Thank you for your continued collaboration as we work to maintain a fair, globally informed admissions process.
